The author's first book comes from the story she wrote after waking one day to see the bull out in the orchard using his horns to grapple with the fruit trees. She initially wrote the story for adults with the title "Don't Let the Bull Prune the Orchard." She realized that she had experienced on the farm many such stories that with a touch of whimsy would enthrall children.

Her current story adds that whimsy to the actions of Uproar the bull and gives the story its central direction when the bull snorts, "I love the Farmer. He is my best friend. I would like to help the Farmer with his work so he can come and take naps with me in the warm sunshine." It is tale of love and friendship that transcends the chaos of a bull pruning the orchard.

The Farm Grandma Tales book series is working to release two books a year for the enjoyment of young readers. For 2023 the upcoming books are "Farm Grandma's Surprise" (June release), and "Chloe Finds a Friend" (October release).
